

BISHOPS PREPARATORY CONCUSSION PLAN

What to do if your child sustains a concussion

- Immediately contact your General Practitioner AND notify Mr Khwezi Mqomboti (kmqomboti@bishops.org.za)
- 2. Once the doctor has ensured there are no complications associated with a head injury and your child is no longer reporting symptoms, a post-injury ImPACT test must be administered at Bishops Prep School. Contact Khwezi Mqomboti on 021 659 7254 / kmqomboti@bishops.org.za to arrange this test.
- 3. If you have been diagnosed with a concussion, you will be advised to rest fully until **symptom free**.
- 4. During this time: Your son must not do any activities that will stimulate the brain. e.g. **NO** television, iPad, cellphone & reading etc.
- 5. The results of the ImPACT test will be sent through to the sports physician or psychologist.
- 6. All final decisions on return-to play will then be made by the sport physician or psychologist.
- 7. Your child will then be advised on the correct return to play protocol.
- 8. If your child is still reporting symptoms or has failed the ImPACT test, he will repeat a further post-injury test in approximately one week until he is at or above his baseline levels.
- 9. Please note that baseline levels need to be repeated annually, due to the ongoing development of the maturing brain.
